Literacy

Reading:

- Independent, guided and modelled reading.
- Reading strategies creating images, skimming, adjusting reading rate, inferring
- Comprehension (Do I understand what I have read?)

Writing:

- Text Type -Poetry
- Adjectives, nouns and verbs
- Sentence structure
- Rocket writing (15 mins of timed writing reflecting an image) **Grammar:** Capital letters, full stops, exclamation marks, question marks

Spelling: Individualised spelling programs focusing on taught sound blends and vowel sounds.

Speaking and listening: Circle time with a focus on PYP learning profiles and attitudes

Handwriting: Revising correct letter formation and finger spacing

Unit of Inquiry

How we express ourselves

An inquiry into the ways in which we discover and express ideas, feelings, nature, culture, beliefs and values; the ways in which we reflect on, extend and enjoy our creativity; our appreciation of the aesthetic.

Central Idea: Our thoughts and feelings are expressed through music. **Lines of inquiry:**

- Sound evokes emotion and how emotions shape sound (perspective)
- How music is made (form)

Assessment:

- Oral presentation about a piece of music .
- Performing a short piece of music to the class which represents an emotion.
- Create an image to accompany a piece of music.

Where are in place and time

An inquiry into orientation in place and time; personal histories; homes and journeys; the discoveries, explorations and migrations of humankind; the relationship between and the interconnectedness of individuals and civilizations, from local and global perspectives.

Central idea: Daily life changes over time.

Lines of inquiry:

- Cultures connect in time and place (connection)
- Daily life has changed over time (change)
- The past is recorded and shared

Assessment:

- Create a time line that details how daily life has changed over time
- Create a Venn diagram of the past and the present

Mathematics

- number sequencing
- number lines
- skip counting
- addition strategies
