SHIVOO - Thursday 1 December 2022


After three years of no live Shivoo, we are excited for its return in 2022. For those who are new to Forrest (or not here three years ago), each year Forrest Primary School has a celebratory, outdoor concert affectionately named Shivoo. This performance showcases our developing talents in movement and music and contributes to our students' learning in the arts. This performance is the culmination of our 'Footsteps' dance programme.

When is Shivoo? Shivoo is on Thursday 1 December with the backup date of Thursday 8 December in case of rescheduling due to wet weather.

What time does it start? Shivoo starts at 6:00pm

Where is Shivoo held? Shivoo will be held on the senior asphalt area outside the school hall.

Where can we sit? In front of the stage. Please see diagram below.



What can we bring to sit on? We suggest you bring a blanket or cushions to sit on in the designated areas. Should you decide to bring a chair, please place it at the side.

Will there be food to purchase? Yes. There will be a sausage sizzle, gozleme, cold drinks and ice creams for sale on the evening. However, if you prefer, you are more than welcome to bring a picnic dinner.

	Costume: Cowboys and cowgirls - jeans, plaid, cowboy hats and boots

	Costume: Black and white with rainbow/sparkle accessories

	Costume: White and Yellow outfit of choice.
